

BRUNSCO BATTLE OF THE BANDS

Entry Requirements

1. Bands must send in a press kit which should include a band bio, list of references/places where the band has performed, and 2-3 video clips. Please indicate your band slot choice on Thursday or Friday with your top 3 choices. If accepted, you will receive your top choice unless it has already been contracted, then 2nd, etc.
2. In order to qualify, you must have material to cover the winning band slot of a 2 ½ hour set at the 39th Annual NC Oyster Festival.
3. Your band must include a minimum of three band members
4. Bands will be contracted at \$500 for a 105 minute set to include a 15 minute break to play on Thursday, April 18th or Friday, April 19th.
5. Bands will have their choice of spot on Thursday or Friday until all spots are full – this is first come, first serve.
6. Bands will be provided with 250 Spring Sling tickets to sell at \$5 each of which the band will be given back \$2 per ticket sold. (More tickets may be requested once 250 have been sold)
7. Band that sells the most tickets will have choice of battle slot, the rest will draw for battle position at 3PM on Saturday, April 20th
8. Sound production, drum set and vocal microphones will be provided.
